

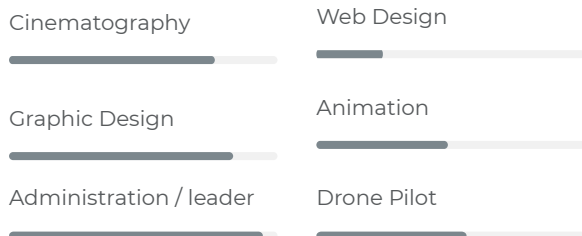


DANIEL GENTZ
